The Priory School 6th Form Travel Bursary

To support those young people who will be joining The Priory 6th Form in September 2025, we are offering a travel bursary of £300 per term. The travel bursary will be paid half-termly to students.

To be eligible for the travel bursary the following criteria will apply:

Distance from the school

- Those students who live 6 miles or more from The Priory School based on their main residency

Eligibility criteria

- Students must be studying three level 3 qualifications (A level and/or Applied general)
- Students must be studying at least two level 3 qualifications (A level and/or Applied general) at The Priory School

Monitoring criteria

- Students must maintain an attendance rate of 96%
- Student must maintain a minimum of Good for attitude to learning
- Students must demonstrate that they are working securely in their current working grade

Removing the travel bursary

Where there are concerns that a young person in receipt of a travel bursary may be at risk of having it withdrawn, the school in conjunction with the young person and parents will put in place a time-limited support programme. The support programme will have agreed objectives with specific outcomes. If at the end of the support programme there is no improvement against the agreed outcomes, the bursary will be removed.

Students travelling from Luton

The aim of the travel bursary is to support students coming to The Priory School. Where there are sufficient numbers of students coming from Luton and it is economically viable to do so, the school will commission a coach company to bring the students to/from school. If the school does provide transportation, then the individual travel bursary will cease to be offered. Parents/carers and students will be notified at least a term in advance of any changes to the travel bursary scheme.
